

2. Plaintiff is suffering irreparable harm and is likely to prevail on the merits of this action.

3. Issuing this temporary restraining order will preserve the ability of this court to issue full relief to Plaintiff if the court rules in favor of Plaintiff on the pending motion for preliminary and permanent injunctive relief.

4. Undersigned counsel has given notice, pursuant to Rule 65 (b), to the Defendants' attorney in this matter of Plaintiff's intention to seek this relief and has provided counsel with a copy of all of the pleadings in this matter.

5. Plaintiff requests the Court to waive the bond requirement in this matter because of the strong public interest in issuance of the preliminary injunction, the inability of the Plaintiff to post the bond, and the slight possibility of harm to Defendants.

6. Further reasons for issuing this temporary restraining order are set out in the memorandum submitted by Plaintiff with this motion.
