- Lori Ann Lassiter is a 62-year-old woman who was convicted of second-degree murder in 1989. She has always maintained her innocence of the crime, but even under the prosecution's theory, Ms. Lassiter at most initiated a robbery for her co-defendant and did not commit any violent act.
- Ms. Lassiter has now served over 38 years in prison, where she has maintained an exemplary conduct record and served her community by, among other things, working in the hospice unit and knitting baby clothes for the Lion's Club.
- Ms. Lassiter has also dedicated her life to becoming clean and sober and furthering her education, including obtaining an associate's degree in business and a certification to work in optical labs.
